#### **Reasons for decision**

The following matters were taken into consideration in making this decision:

- the relevant matters listed in section 4.15 of the Act and the additional matters listed in the statutory context section of the Department's Assessment Report;
- the prescribed matters under the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000;
- the objects of the Act;
- all information submitted with the development application and during the assessment and information considered in the Department's Assessment Report;
- the findings and recommendations in the Department's Assessment Report; and
- the views of the community about the project (see Attachment 1).

The findings and recommendations set out in the Department's Assessment Report were accepted and adopted as the reasons for making this decision.

The key reasons for granting consent to the development application are as follows:

- the project is permissible with development consent under the State Environmental Planning Policy (Kosciuszko Nation Park – Alpine Resorts) 2007 and is consistent with NSW Government policies including the South East and Tableland Regional Plan 2036 aim to increase visitation to the NSW ski resorts.
- There would be no impacts on the community and the environment;
- no issues were raised by the community during exhibition of the proposal; and
- weighing all relevant considerations, the project is in the public interest.

The Department exhibited the application from 11 May 2020 to 25 May 2020, the Application was made publicly available on the Department's website. Comments were received from the National Parks and Wildlife Service and the Rural Fire Service. No other submissions were received.
